Main decisions

To develop adaptation agenda for sand for sandy coastal system based on the principles of 'prevention as top priority, maintain territory and coastal foundation zone in balance with relative rise in sea levels'

Current sandy coastal system: this will include sediment transport increase in sand replenishment required in relation to the relative rise in sea levels, the sand demand of the open basins with erosion of the outer delt

Dunes as an integral part of the sandy coastal system ensure adaptation to relative rise in sea levels through management, maintenance and increase in sand replenishment

Former inlet closed off using hard elements, putting an end to sediment transport

issue of open basins adapting to sea level rise by increasing sand replenishments
